<u>Increments and Transformations</u>	
<b>Make an Improvement; Assess and further improve; Help faculty colleagues</b>	
<b>Make at least one improvement</b>	
Improvement in at least one course Identify a topic, issue, etc. where you would like to improve T/L using info tech	
<b>Triad</b>	
<b>Triad - Goal/Benefit</b> <i>Educational Outcome:</i> Students make [better? faster?] progress toward some skill, knowledge, etc. in one course, in their major and/or across different disciplines (and over several years?) <b>Savings:</b> How this LTA saves time, money or stress <b>Outcome of Ease/Efficiency:</b> How and to what extent the results are easier and less stressful to achieve (especially in the long term) than via other methods

<b>Assess and further improve</b> at least one aspect of that change (steering corrections; go/no go; accelerator info; mid-course corrections..)	
Sources of sample items, questions, survey templates, study designs .... RELEVANT TO THIS "IMPROVEMENT" from the TLT Group and/or elsewhere	
Kinds of info that will be elicited and likely be used almost immediately to confirm a practice or make a further improvement in the same direction	
Kind of info that will be elicited that may not be applied to affirming or modifying "improving the improvement" until next semester or next academic year
